How Credit Recovery Works

- Pre-Tests** identify mastered objectives and do not count toward a grade.

- Post-Tests** measure mastery, with a **60% passing threshold** and unlimited attempts.
- Courses include **pacing guides** and helpful introductory videos to support student success from day one.



Essential Things for Families to Know

- Courses are offered in **semester formats**.
- Credit Recovery courses are intended to be an **abbreviated experience** as students should already have **some functional understanding of the content**.
- These courses are **not NCAA eligible** and are distinct from remediation or auto-graded courses.
